- I. Selection: Appointment by other elders
- II. Answer to: Jesus Christ, the Chief Shepherd
- III. Oversee: People in the church
- IV. Glorify God by:
 - A. Knowing and being known by people in the church (must be hospitable, compassionate, approachable).
 - B. Guarding themselves and protecting fellow elders so that all are living "above reproach."
 - C. Modeling servant leadership and humility at home and in ministry.
 - D. Providing spiritual oversight for the church as a whole.
 - E. Studying the scriptures.
 - F. Praying for the needs of the church
 - G. Prioritizing needs and shaping church vision consistent with our mission statement
 - H. Hiring/firing, evaluating, and holding accountable Lead Pastor.
 - I. Exercising church discipline when necessary (Matt 18).
 - J. Teaching and mentoring others.
 - K. Aggressively protecting against false teachers and those who might harm or divide the church (Acts 20:28-30; Titus 1:9-10).
 - L. Praying for the sick (James 5:14-15).
